Permits this month -

a. 23-20E N Meadow Creek (Owens)

Notes: Emergency permit to clear trees and debris in the creek that was causing creek to flood alfalfa fields and flooding crops.

b. 23-21E N Meadow Creek (Owens)

Notes: Emergency permit for blockage on Hamilton property that is diverting creek out of its channel and flooding crops/eroding road.

c. 23-23 Madison River Storey Ditch (MRF)

Notes: Habitat enhancement, bank revegetation, riparian planting

d. 23-24 O'Dell Creek (Granger Ranches)

Notes: Bridge replacement

Existing bridge will be removed intact. New stringers layed from bank to bank (approximately 35 ft). A deck will be built on new stringers.

e. 23-25 Cedar Creek (CCR Connolly)

Notes: Bridge replacement

The existing concrete abutment that is falling into the stream will be removed from the channel. We will dig a trench for the abutment 20' farther into the bank to increase the span width from 30' to 50'. The old abutment will be bedded in and a \sim 50'x10' rail car deck will be placed on top of this and the remaining river-right abutment. If the old river-left abutment is damaged when moving it, preformed concrete blocks will be used to reconstruct the river-left abutment.

c. 310 Moore Creek Conflict

Notes: There is a potential conflict of interest with permitting the 3 hardened water gaps on the Goggins property as part of the Moore Creek Restoration Project that the MCD is facilitating and partially funding. There are two options: 1) MCD can be the applicant, which will kick the permitting responsibility to FWP as a 124 permit, or 2) the MCD could transfer responsibility of issuing the permit to Ruby Valley Conservation District (RVCD) or Gallatin Conservation District (GCD). Option 2 would require approval by the board of one of the two other neighboring conservation districts and, potentially, could require the MCD to pay RVCD travel expenses or GCD travel expenses and contracted permitting services by Respec.
